



Small Animal Rotating Internship

New England Animal Medical Center offers a rotating internship with a primary focus on clinical training with weekly didactic experiences and quality of life. Our practice provides training in the areas of emergency and critical care, internal medicine, surgery in addition to general practice. The internship includes rotations in internal medicine, surgery, and general day practice that total approximately 50% of the interns' time. The remainder of the internship time is spent on emergency receiving and critical care rotations. External rotations can be arranged to broaden the internship experience. Clinical training allows for primary case responsibility and the opportunity to be the primary surgeon on emergency cases under the supervision of senior staff and specialists. In addition to the training in the core rotations, the program includes extensive exposure to cardiology and radiology. We currently have residency training programs in surgery and in emergency and critical care medicine. The didactic components of the program include topic based lectures, journal club, EKG rounds and morbidity and mortality rounds. In addition, interns may attend weekly resident level seminars.
